 and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and
 Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this eighth day of February in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy
 nine My Albin's Mark X (L) Signed sealed
 published and declared by the within named Testatrix
 Amy Albin to be her last Will and Testament in the
 presence of us who subscribed our names in presence
 of the said Testatrix and of each other William Havers
 Peter Gaultier

This Will

was proved at London on
 the sixth day of March in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine before
 the Reverend William Mather Doctor of Laws
 surrogate of the Right Worshipful Peter Cahoon
 Doctor of Laws Master Sheperd or Commissioner of the
 Probate Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by
 the oath of George Albin the son of the deceased
 and the sole Executor named in the said Will to whom
 Administration was granted of all and singular the
 Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased having
 first sworn duly to administer.

 knowing and understanding do make and ordain this

 Woolwich in Kent composed of Shipwrights and others
 and after the payment of my Debts and funeral
