This is the last Will and Testament
of me Judith Mcher of the parish of Charlton in the County of
Kent made and signed this first day of June in the year of our
lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine first desire
that I may be decently and privately buried by and under the
direction of the Executor of this my will and I direct that all my
just debts funeral and testamentary costs charges and expences
shall be paid and satisfied by him out of my personal estate as
soon as conveniently may be after my decease and I give and
bequeath unto my friend John Martin Bulmer of the parish
of Stood in the County of Kent a legary of ten pounds
and I appoint him the said John Martin Bulmer sole
Executor of this my will also I give and bequeath all my
clothing apparel and personal linen unto and equally between
and amongst my nieces Ann Marsden Bidore my niece Sarah
Soliman Bidore my niece Harriott Pearson the wife of
Pearson my niece Fanny Poastier the wife of John Poastier and
Martha Farmer (the wife of John Farmer) who is now residing
with me and subject to and charged and chargeable with the
payment of all my just debts funeral and testamentary costs
charges and expences and the legary herebefore bequeathed
I give and bequeath all my household estates and all the
rest residue and remainder of my personal estate and
effects whatsoever and wheresoever unto my friend the said John
Martin Bulmer his executors administrators and assigns with
full authority to compound debts submit differences to arbitration
give receipts execute assignments assurances and releases and to
do and to do in all acts and arrangements for realizing my
estates and settling my affairs according to his or their direction
upon trust to convert and get in all my household estates and the
rest residue and remainder of my personal estate and effects
and to invest the money to arise therefrom and thereby (after
deducting thereout and therefrom all attendant costs charges and
expences) together with all my ready moneys on government or a
good securities in England and upon further trust to pay the annual
income thereof or of the securities thereon the same shall be
invested from time to time as it shall arise and in
become due unto my brother John Sabden for and during the
term of his natural life and from and after the determination of
that trust as to the principal of the said trust fund on trust for my
sister the said Ann Marsden Bidore my said niece the said Sarah
Soliman Bidore my niece the said Harriott Pearson my niece
the said Fanny Poastier my niece Sophia Delius the wife of
Delius and the said Martha Farmer who is now residing
with me to redom accordingly I give and bequeath the same
principal of the said trust fund in equal shares as tenants in
common and not as joint tenants the same to be vested at my
decease although not payable until the decease of my said
brother John Sabden and I direct that the legaries to such of the
several herebefore named legaries as at the time of the actual

 paid into their respective proper hands in order that the same may
 may be enjoyed and disposed of as their separate property free from
 from marital control and for which legacies their respective receipts
 without their husbands shall be good and sufficient discharges
 to my Executor and hereby revoking and declaring void all other
 wills heretofore made & declare this to be my last will and in a
 Testament in witness whereof to this my last will and Testament
 contained in this and the preceding sheet of paper I have set my
 hand on the day and year first above written. *The mark of the*
above named Judith & Alchin the Testatrix — Signed by the above named
 Judith Alchin the testatrix as and for her last will and Testament
 in the presence of us present at the same time & in her request
 in her presence and in the presence of each other have subscribed

Proved at London 22nd April 1841 before the Reverend John
 Saubrey Doctor of Laws & Surrogate by the oath of John Martin a
 Bachelor the sole Exor to whom admou was granted having been
 first sworn duly to administer.

This is the last Will and Testament
 of me Frances Anand of Portsmouth in the County of Southampton
 Southampton Widdow as follows (that is to say) I desire that my body
 may be deposited in the Vault wherein my late husband was
 buried in Saint Thomas Church in Portsmouth aforesaid with a
 suitable decency but without funeral pomp & give and bequeath a
 unto my eldest son Elias Anand the sum of one hundred pounds
 & hereby constitute and appoint Henry Anand Clarke of West
 Square London Road in the County of Surrey Gentleman and the
 Reverend Henry Dicks of Warburton in the County of Southampton
 to be the Executors of this my will and I bequeath to each of
 them the sum of fifty pounds as some compensation for the
 trouble and personal expenses they will be put to in the
 performance of the trusts or otherwise in or about the execution
 of this my will & will and direct that all my just debts funeral and
 testamentary expenses and the legacies heretofore given be
 paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently may be after my
 decease I give and bequeath all the Rest Residue and Remains
 of my moveable goods funds and securities for money goods chattels
 and personal Estate and Effects whatsoever and whatsoever not
 heretofore disposed of and which shall remain after payment
 of my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses unto the said
 Henry Anand Clarke and Henry Dicks their executors and
 administrators upon trust to call in and convert the same into
 money as soon as conveniently may be after my decease and to
 divide the money so to be called in and to arise from my said
 residuary personal estate and effects into three equal parts and
 as to one of such equal third parts upon trust to pay the same
 unto my son John Anand to whom I give and bequeath the
 same for his own absolute use and benefit and as to one other
 of such equal third parts of the money so to be called in and to
 arise from my said residuary personal estate and effects it is my
 will that the said Henry Anand Clarke and Henry Dicks or
 their assigns or the survivor of them his executors administrators
