Lease menconed for the payment thereof and in full discharge and satisfaction thereof and not otherwise Provided always further and my will and meaning notwithstanding further is That if it shall happen That Thomas my brother his heirs exors or administrators shall make default in payment of the said sume of three hundred pounds To the said Anne my wife contrary to the Promise or condition in the said indenture of lease mentioned for payment thereof Then immediately after such default made my will and meaning is That I give and devise to all those my lands and tenements menconed in my said wills Joynture and also in the said indenture of lease which are situate lying and being in Oddy aforesaid in the County aforesaid formerly in this my will given and devised to the said Thomas my brother and his heirs upon condition as aforesaid shall be utterly frustrate and void And then and in that tale I give and devise the said lands and tenements situate lying and being in Oddy aforesaid in the County aforesaid formerly given and devised to the said Thomas my brother and his heirs To the said Anne my wife To have and to hold the same to her the said Anne and to her heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath to the said Anne my wife All my moveable goods household stuffe and personall Estate To have and to hold the same to her and her assigns for ever Item I give and bequeath to the said Edward Little my brother in law ffive pounds of lawfull money of England to buy him a Ring the said to be paid by the said Thomas my brother and Exors hereafter named out of those lands and tenements by this my will formerly given and devised unto him And my will and meaning further is That the said Thomas Aldhouse my brother shall out of the said lands for bequeathed unto him as aforesaid pay and discharge All my just and true debts the Charges of my funerall and Probate of this my will And I nominate constitute and appoint the said Thomas Aldhouse my brother sole Exorator of this my last will and Testament earnestly entreating him to see the same in all things duly executed and performed In WITNES whereof I have to this my last will and Testament being torkyred in ffour sheets of Paper sett to curry of them my hand and to them all my Seale the day and year first above written John Aldhouse Sealed Published and subscribed in the presens of Edward Dillott Robert Brown

 the earth at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named Item I doe
 give and bequeath unto my Cousen Abraham Olthorne of Retherfeld -
 aforesaid the sume of ffive pounds to be paid to him within one yeare
 next after my decease Upon Condition and with this Proviso That he
 my said Cousen Abraham Olthorne shall and doe permit and suffer
 my said Executor peaceably and quietly to have hold and enjoy the messuage
 and Tenement whereon I now live with the appurtenances the which I now
 hold and enjoy by vertue of or under a certain Lease thereof long since
 to me made by my father Jasper Olthorne now deceased for the terme
 of diverse yeares a great part whereof are yet to come and unexpired
 for and during so long tyme and for many yeares as are and is yet
 to come and unexpired of the aforesaid Terme according to the true
 intent and meaning of the said Lease And if my said Cousen Abraham
 Olthorne shall or doe refuse to permit my said Executor to enjoy and
 hold the same accordingly or doe molest trouble or sue her or them for
 or touching the same Then my will and mind is that the said
